Update Report From The Capital Campaign Steering Committee

We are very pleased to report that, since 2005, the Parish Capital Campaign has received 402 pledges representing over 1,000 of our parishioners and school families for a total of:

\$1,127,760.00
with \$686,427.00 already collected (as of June 2008)

Here is a list of major projects that have been completed:

1. Installation of a state of the art energy efficient heating system for the Church and the old section of the school.
2. Complete restoration of the school roof.
3. Installation of exterior lighting on the Church plaza.
4. Installation of new security lighting for the main parking lot and school yard.
5. Installation of two new handicap accessible restrooms and a new kitchen facility in Conran Hall.
6. Repairs to the lighting and electrical systems in the Conran Hall kitchen and rest room complex.
7. Restoration of two restrooms in the school.
8. Restoration of the ceiling fans in Conran Hall.
9. Installation of new exterior doors for the school.
10. Installation of a new gas heating system, new floors, new pews, and a new roof at Saint Nicholas Chapel.
11. Restoration of the Allen Digital Organ at Saint Nicholas Chapel.
12. Relocation of the CCD Office to the new Religious Education Center located in the former second grade classroom.
13. Furnishing of the new Religious Education Center with computer terminals, desks, conference room tables and chairs, air conditioning, telephone system and electrical upgrades.

14. Repairs to the Kindergarten classroom and re-pointing of the brick entrance.
15. Repair, restoration and refinishing of all the Church pews, with the pews refitted to the existing kneelers.
16. Installation of a completely new Church floor, with the creation of a spacious handicap seating area that is heel chair accessible.
17. Complete cleaning and repainting of the Church ceiling.
18. Complete removal of the Church roof and installation of a new roof.
19. Repaving of the small school yard parking lot.

These remarkable accomplishments have been realized thanks to your prayers and generous support. So much can be accomplished when we come together as a family.

We are also pleased to report the completion of two additional projects generated by our parishioners:

1. Thanks to the cooperative efforts of the Saint Teresa's Family Guild, the Holy Name Society, and the Cub / Boy Scout Apostolate, the much needed repainting of the lower Church hall has been completed, and the results are spectacular! The funds for this project were raised at our very successful Car Show, which took place earlier this summer. The Church hall is now clean and bright. Thanks to all who made this possible.
2. The Servant of God Terence Cardinal Cooke Youth Activities Association (YAA) has successfully completed a major improvement project in Conran Hall. The entire gym floor has been stripped, sanded, repainted and revarnished. Additionally, the entire gym has been repainted, and the facility is now ready to welcome our kids as the fall sports program begins. Thanks to the leadership of the YAA, this much needed project is now a reality!

This has been, to say the least, a very busy, exciting summer, and we hope you're pleased with the results. This is a great parish, and we are thrilled to bring you up to date on all that is happening. We are committed to the restoration of the Parish spiritually and physically. As we lift up each and every one you in prayer, we kindly ask that you keep the Parish in your prayers as well, that the blessings of our good and gracious God may come in abundance on all!
